- While there are benefits to home-based programs, C.A.B.S. prioritizes clinic-based options allowing our team to collaborate, co-treat and maintain consistent schedules for our clients. A clinic-based model with salaried staff also allows for limited cancelations and interruptions to services.
- While credentialing is not a requirement to provide services in your state, 100% of C.A.B.S. behavior technicians are Registered Behavior Technicians who have completed training and passed required practical and written examinations. In addition, they receive a minimum of 2-4 hours a week of supervision required to maintain their RBT credential.





## Who We Serve

At C.A.B.S. we believe that learning never ends but understand that priorities and goals change as our learners enter their teen and young adult years. We serve learners and young adults aged 2-26. We know that our clients' needs change throughout their lifetime and are here to support them at every stage. Often our younger learners will return years later when new challenges of school, puberty or transitions to adulthood occur.



Our clients come from a variety of backgrounds with different needs including, but not limited to:

- Toddlers and preschoolers who are not yet speaking, have trouble with play skills, and who may not be potty trained yet
- School-aged clients who may not be making progress on IEP goals, are getting sent home for behaviors or anxiety, or are not being supported in ways necessary to learn in a school or group setting
- Learners who struggle outside the structure of school and fall apart when presented with new routines, social situations or struggle with emotional and behavioral regulation
- Teens who need to gain independence in self-care, daily living skills, and self-advocacy
- Young adults who do not have the skills to be independent in a job or adult workshop setting
